Event or Activity	Scheduling Recommendation	Notes
<b>Member Retention</b>		
Chapter meetings	Weekly	Virtually meet or follow state, local, university, and CDC guidelines if meeting in person
Sisterhood events	Once per month	Review the virtual sisterhood guide
Committee meetings	Monthly	Virtually retain members without officer positions through committee meetings
Leadership development	At least once per semester	Utilize the national leadership development program or other virtual training opportunities
Member appreciation	Weekly	Virtually highlight graduating members through this
<b>Member Well Being</b>		
Wellness activities	At least once a month	Virtually meet to participate in self-care and wellness activities
Constitution and bylaws review workshop	At least once per semester	This review workshops can be help during a chapter meeting at the beginning of each semester to set clear expectations and ensure understanding of membership

Event or Activity	Scheduling Recommendation	Notes
<b>Service</b>		
Project Plan	Schedule 60% projects within 2 weeks of start of semester and submit to Service Program Coordinator for review	Consider virtual projects only even if your university allows in-person events
<b>Chapter Growth</b>		
Recruitment	<p>Market recruitment 1 month before recruitment starts</p> <p>Recruitment week should start a week or two after classes have started</p> <p>Recruitment should be 1-2 weeks long (longer this semester due to COVID)</p>	Virtually, in-person or a combination of both depending on university guidelines
Bid day	Immediately following recruitment	Virtually, in-person or a combination of both depending on university guidelines
New member ceremony	Recommend to be held on same day as bid day	Virtually, in-person or a combination of both depending on university guidelines
Big/Little	Reveal should happen halfway through the NM process	Virtually, in-person or a combination of both depending on university guidelines
<b>Chapter Operations</b>		
Executive Board meetings	Weekly	Recommended to be held virtually once a week even if more often than in past semesters
Chapter Development Meeting with EB (CEP)	Early in fall semester	Recommended to be held virtually only
CSB meetings	As defined in chapter bylaws	Recommended to be held virtually only
Elections	As defined in chapter bylaws	Virtually or hybrid, depending on university guidelines
Officer training and transition	At the end of term post-elections with continued training as necessary	Virtually or hybrid, depending on university guidelines
Fundraisers	At least twice a semester	Virtual only for Fall 2020
